

Please note: THERE IS NO ONE RIGHT WAY TO DO CHART HARMONY. In the end, *uou* live your chart and these tools are offered to you with all mu love and with all the wisdom of the spirits of my mother, the astrologer, and her mother, a true "Rosie the Riveter" who taught me how to read fortunes using a deck of playing cards.

So much of astrology is a way of providing permission to be the versions of ourselves we already feel tugged to be. I love the a-ha moments that come from this work.

The following pages will detail how to prep for our free webinar by rendering your chart using the Whole Sign House System, learning to recognize the glyphs in use on your chart, and playing with some keywords as you begin to consider what you'd like to invite into your life for 2025 and beyond. our schedule:



1: PREP YOURSELF

Use this workbook to learn how to render your free chart in the format we'll use during the webinar; get an overview of glyphs and keywords that will help you get familiar with the lingo we'll use; find space to journal.

2: OUR FORMULA

The planet is the WHAT, the sign is the HOW, and the house is the WHERE. Using this formula, we can zoom in on any issue in your life, making areas that are in need of some Chart Harmony remedies very clear!

3: THE COLORS

Chart Harmony is easiest to approach from a color-coded POV. This helps us see the calendar (and our lives) NOT in approximately a bazilliondy different astrological components but instead in 6 colors and remedies associated with each.

4: DATES & TRANSITS

This is what you came for! (Maybe! Maybe you're here for the easy color-coding process. Maybe you're here for ALL of it. Yay!) With this info, you'll be able to mark up your calendar and know what to expect, when.

5: CHART HARMONY

Here's where the magic happens! I'll guide you through a few remedies that align beautifully with various needs, different lifestyles, and all levels of woo! Remember, this is just a starting point; there's no race here! Just a deeper sense of connection with your truest self.

6: Q&A







If you already have your chart in the Whole Sign House System format, skip ahead. Otherwise, visit **astro.com** and select the **Horoscopes** menu from the top left area. This will expand a multi-column menu. From here, choose **Extended Chart Selection** from the **Drawings, Calculations, Data** section.





From here, proceed as a **guest user** (or create an account). Once you click the words **click here to go to the data entry page** in the **guest user** section, you'll click through to AGREE to terms and then land on a form you'll fill out with your birth information so the site can render your free natal chart!





You'll notice how I've filled out the form: name, gender (ugh, dated gender options), birthday, hour and minute of birth, country of birth, and then as I fill in the birth town, the site provides options (including longitude and latitude) to select from. Once I've made the selection, it's time to render my chart!





Now we're gonna shift from the default HOUSE system to **Whole Signs**. Before you click on the everso-tempting button that says "Click here to show the chart," expand the "Options for zodiac and houses" menu and select the **Whole Signs** option. This makes learning the houses more straightforward.





Once you've clicked on the "Click here to show the chart" button, you'll be seeing your **Whole Sign** birth chart (maybe for the first time). **Yay!** There's a lot here, so don't get overwhelmed. When you click on the chart, a new tab will open with a printable chartwheel and tables with astrological glyphs.

If you'd like to save your chart (and not just print it), when you are prompted by your browser's PRINT command to send the chart to the printer, just choose to save the chart as a PDF (this is a drop-down menu in my print window; it may look a little different for you, but it'll be in this general area). Doing this should put a PDF of your chart somewhere on your computer to revisit later! (You'll notice I changed the print scale to 86%. This is so my chart and the staircase table all fits on ONE page. You may have to do a similar adjustment.)

glyphs, modalities, elements:

Each of the fun symbols you see on your chart has meaning. This page covers a bunch of 'em. NOTE: There are variations in some signs (like Capricorn) and planets (like Pluto) and there's no different meaning implied when any particular version is used. Think of it like cursive vs. block letters.

Each sign has a **Modality**; the disposition from which it does its work. For example, Capricorn is a Cardinal sign, so it does its Capricorn business from a POV of leadership. Consider Modality a way to notice relationships between the parts of your natal chart.

CARDINAL: Aries, Cancer, Libra, Capricorn (the leaders) **FIXED**: Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius (the upholders)

MUTABLE: Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces (the shape-shifters)

Each sign also has an **Element**; that's how it does its work. For example, Taurus is an Earth sign, and that means it does its Taurus business in a grounded, physical kind of way. This is another opportunity to check for common threads in how various signs relate!

FIRE: Aries, Leo, Sagittarius (passionate and magical)

EARTH: Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn (willing to put in the work)


AIR: Gemini, Libra, Aquarius (bubbling over with ideas)

WATER: Cancer, Scorpio, Pisces (intuitive and emotional)

The staircase table for your chart (as rendered by Astro.com) showcases symbols that indicate the relationships between placements (aspects). While a deep-dive on these is outside the scope of our free training, stay curious about what you're seeing! And come join us in **Live Your Chart** to dive deeper, of course.

relationship matrix:

Using the glyphs from the previous page as you consult the table on this page, notice patterns: the Elements some of the signs have in common, the Modalities some of them share too. Do the signs' commonalities make sense to you when you think of people you know? When you think about all the parts of your own chart?



Consider writing the symbols (or words, if you're not yet glyph-fluent) along the outside of your natal chartwheel. This will help you navigate your chart at a glance as the webinar moves through the woo weather to come. Bonus points for including some keywords in your labeling! NOTE: In addition to the Elements and Modalities, the signs also have polarities and seasons. There's an "age" to each sign... and body parts each one governs as well! One of the coolest parts of **Chart Harmony** is the ability to get incredibly creative as we use storytelling to remember which factors help us heal, bring our lives into balance, and have more fun! I love this so dang much.

the signs:

You certainly know "your sign" (this is the horoscope you may read from time to time). What you're looking at in that case is the sign the Sun was in when you were born. Of course, you *have* all 12 signs in your chart! Just look at the outside of the chartwheel. All 12 signs are players in your life's story *and* a map for how you can invite in everything you've ever dreamed of... even using "empty" houses. NOTE: These GENERAL dates for Sun signs sometimes shift due to the 360° chartwheel vs. the 365-day calendar year. Ah, human time is so adorable. Use the below details to familiarize yourself with the various energetic signatures of these signs (the **HOW** part of our formula).

ARIES: March 21-April 19. The zodiac's puppy! Enthusiastic, excited, self-directed, ambitious, courageous, bold, pioneering, curious, likely to act first and think later (maybe).

TAURUS: April 20-May 20. Slow and steady! Stubborn, practical, stable, loyal, determined, slow to anger, lover of good food. Adores things that feel great and are built to last.

GEMINI: May 21-June 20. Up all night talking! Intellectual, expressive, adaptable, clever, versatile, chatty, musical, usually good with their hands, and always up for debates. Loves finding out what ELSE is going on.

CANCER: June 21-July 22. Home is where the heart is! Sensitive, nurturing, creative, protective, emotional, intuitive, reserved, family-focused, strong. Will use that big-ass claw when backed into a corner.

LEO: July 23-August 22. Strut your stuff! Affectionate, generous, proud to lead, slow to change, loyal, creative, confident, charismatic, dramatic. Always leading from the heart.

VIRGO: August 23-September 22. I have a list! Intelligent, analytical, discriminating, critical, detail-oriented. This self-sacrificing healer can do a better job than anyone else, always.

LIBRA: September 23-October 22. Balance is motion! Diplomatic, artistic, beautiful, fair, indecisive, relationship-focused, opportunistic, charming. The ultimate people-pleaser (this is why they cannot make decisions).

SCORPIO: October 23-November 21. Intensely passionate! Secretive, sexy, calculating, resourceful, determined, willful. Learns your secrets, goes deep, and connects to your very soul. They specialize in transformations!

SAGITTARIUS: November 22-December 21. Born to explore! Idealistic, bold, philosophical, self-educated, world-traveler, confident, blunt, generous, optimistic, enthusiastic, lucky, adaptable, expansive. Always ready for an adventure!

CAPRICORN: December 22-January 19. There's always work to do! Ambitious, powerful, organized, structured, cautious, practical, economical, born to lead. There's no mountain this seagoat won't climb.

AQUARIUS: January 20-February 18. Let your freak flag fly! Rebellious, idealistic, friendly, cooperative, detached, altruistic, innovative, progressive. Truly DGAF in all the best ways.

PISCES: February 19-March 20. Pure magic! Sensitive, psychic, intuitive, artistic, mystical, musical, compassionate, empathetic, insecure, secretive. Lives in other worlds and loses time (and sometimes their pants).

the planets & placements:

All righty... now it's time to dive in on the planets and placements of your chart. While there are all sorts of minor planets, fixed stars, and asteroids out there, for our free training, we're gonna keep the focus on the following characters. Remember, we're dealing with the **WHAT** in the formula for navigating your chart. (Visit my fabulous free trainings **What Your Birthday Says About You** and **Chart Harmony 101** for more about your **Life-Car**.)

THE SUN: This life-giving luminary is your ego, your sense of self, your essence, your spirit, your source of will, your vitality, your authority. It's the navigator of your **Life-Car**!

THE MOON: Your emotional body is deeply tied to the Moon. Your feelings, instinct, and intuition come from the setpoint of your natal Moon *and* fluctuate with what the Moon does, day to day. This is your inner home; it's how you feel safe. It's also the backseat driver in your **Life-Car**, making sure everyone's needs are met.

YOUR RISING: Also known as your **Ascendant** (**AC**, **AS**, or **ASC**), this is your belief system and daily life. It's how you come across, your physical characteristics, and your personal style. This is the driver of your **Life-Car**; the Ruling Planet of your Rising sign has a lot to do with how you show up in the world.

MERCURY: Ruler of communication, travel, personal technology, how you learn, what you believe, and how you speak about what you know... all packed in one shifty little prankster of a planet. Your reasoning and dexterity are tethered here.

VENUS: How you love, see beauty, find balance, and deal with money — yep, money mindset *and* love languages — are all in one place! Your core values, relationships, harmony, enoughness, charm, sensuality, artistic talents... they're all shaped by Venus.

MARS: The warrior planet is all about your motivation, fire for fighting and... another F word.;) Look here for your passion, physical energy, stamina, courage, temper, drive for achieving, and impulsive urges.

JUPITER: This is how you get lucky! If the planets all go to Vegas, Jupiter is driving the party bus! Jupiter is all about expansion, gifts, and blessings in life, adding glitter to your vision, faith, philosophical setpoint, and flair for doing the most! You'll never get an apology for all the exclamation points Jupiter wants to use!

SATURN: It's back to basics time. Saturn is "the dad planet" (and we all have daddy issues) because it's making sure you're doing what you came here to do. Saturn is a minimalist, all about contraction, limits, structure, focus, rules, and tenacity. Saturn is the planet of shoulds, shame, setting boundaries, and saying NO.

URANUS: Your rebellious innovation is here. If you're gonna think outside the box, Uranus will be how you do it, with a dash of independent eccentricity. Uranus asks: "Where am I not free?" and then creates a revolution in that part of your life, in the name of freedom.

NEPTUNE: Reply hazy; try again. This is the planet of deception, mystery, magic, creativity, spirituality, illusion, acting, and the supernatural. Check here for secrets, addictions, and surprising help from beyond!


PLUTO: I call Pluto the TOWER card. If you know tarot, you get the picture. This is a powerful generational planet of transformation. The sign it's in, in your chart, represents what your age group came to transmute, kill off, or forever change in our world! NBD. ;)

YOUR MIDHEAVEN: Noted on your chart as **MC**, this is the ambition for your higher calling and your public career reputation.

YOUR NORTH NODE: Your destiny. Your life's purpose. All the things beyond your perceived limits and practiced beliefs. As challenging as writing with your non-dominant hand. Doable, but quite uncomfortable to get used to!

planetary rulers:

Each sign has a ruler. That's a planet whose energy is in charge of that sign's **HOW** (remember, the planet is the **WHAT**, the sign is the **HOW**, and the house is the **WHERE** it all shows up). Using traditional rulership, we've got **7 planets** and luminaries that rule the **12 signs**. What kind of energy is dominant in your chart? Which planets make up the vibe of your **Life-Car**? (Review my free trainings **What Your Birthday Says About You** and **Chart Harmony 101** if you're not sure.) Are the nooks and crannies of your natal chart (and therefore your personality) starting to make more sense now?



Consider that your Chart Ruler is likely in a sign that is ruled by *another* planet. THAT combination actually flavors how your personality expresses (the house influences **WHERE** your energy is most focused). There are so many layers to this! I love it! I hope you're loving it too. Remember to come jam with us at Discord! We'd love to meet you and your **Life-Car**.

the houses:

Hey, here's our handy formula for basic astrology again: The planet is the **WHAT**, the sign is **HOW**, and the house is the **WHERE**. Example: A **Venus** in **Leo** in the **11th House** (Bonnie Gillespie) = all the loving and valuing and beautifying is done in a very grand, passionate, public way specifically in broader communities and in service of utopian, innovative, progressive visions for us all. As your **Chart Harmony** exploration deepens, you'll begin to uncover your own loglines for all the parts of your chart!

1st HOUSE: Your personality, your body, and the impression that you make all live here (it's the house of your Rising sign AKA Ascendant). This is the only house that's ALL ABOUT YOU.

2nd HOUSE: This is where we find your values, your desires, your enoughness, your belongings (AKA your "stuff"), and your income earned from working.

3rd HOUSE: Your closest friends, siblings, cousins, and networking activities can be found here, plus communication, social media, and local travel.

4th HOUSE: Your family of origin, home, heritage, "unseen parent," family land, and ancestry are rooted here. Look here for beliefs you inherited too!

5th HOUSE: This is where you'll find your creative expression, joy, friskiness, risk-taking, gambling, drama, childlike glee, affairs, and outright pleasure in life. Your children show up in this house too.

6th HOUSE: Daily practices, your health and fitness, acts of service, and the jobby-job work you do (not your True North purpose in life) are here. This includes your co-workers and employees. Pets hang out in this house as well.

7th HOUSE: This is where partnerships live (both business and romantic partnerships, always 1:1). This can include your coaches, your therapists, your agents... and even your enemies! You're never solo in this house.

8th HOUSE: Your money issues are here (usually other people's money, investments in you, or loans you take out and taxes you pay) as well as your shadow work, secrets, sexual intimacy, death/transformation, and legacy.

9th HOUSE: Your love for learning; higher education; traveling great distances; and exploring things like religion, publishing, astrology, and law are anchored here.


10th HOUSE: Your chart's most visible stage! This is your public image, higher calling, and how you're seen in the world. It's where your True North, your ambition, and your brand meet! Issues with your "public parent" are here too.

11th HOUSE: This is your house of community, friends, tech, activism, an idealistic view of the future, and innovative dreams for the greater good of the collective.

12th HOUSE: "The house of your undoing," this is where your (karmic, mental health) secrets, thoughts on loop, and confinements live. But also so much magic, like mysticism, spirituality, and intuition! Institutions (from hospitals to jails to retreat venues to rehab to systems we live by) hang out here too.

the houses at a glance:

Because we all learn differently, here's a graphic depiction of the same basic information as you saw in list form on the previous page. **NOTE**: We all have all 12 houses! Also worth noting: No matter what house system you use, your 1st house (**1H**) is the one that hosts your Rising (Ascendant, ASC, AC, or AS, depending on what software or app you use to render your chart). 1H is the most PERSONAL of all 12 houses. All other houses have "co-stars" sharing the space!



numerology for 2025:

Even without someone's birthtime or birthplace, we can calculate what sort of year they're having using numerology. To calculate your personal year, use ONLY the month and day you were born (do NOT include the year you were born). Combine the month and day of your birth with the current year, adding everything down 'til you get to a single digit. That's your numerology for the year! (To learn all about your **birth number**, head over to my free training called **What Your Birthday Says About You**. I've gotchuu!)

Let's do my numerology for 2025 as an example for you to follow. My birthday is July 11th (remember, we don't use the birth year for this).

7 + 1 + 1 + 2 + 0 + 2 + 5 = 18 (but that's still not a single digit, so...) 1 + 8 = 9

2025, for me, has a numerological signature of 9. Okay!

1 YEAR: New beginnings! Planting seeds with all the drive and enthusiasm for initiating that the 1 year is famous for creating. Be purposeful with the goals you set and the projects, relationships, and commitments you begin this year, as they'll be the foundation for your life and work for the next 9 years.

2 YEAR: Receptive energy! Now it's all about nurturing the seeds you planted last year. My mother called this the "abort or knit booties" year because we are either digging up in doubt what we planted in faith... or we're activating the divine emotional mind-body to help those little seeds grow strong!

3 YEAR: Manifestation time! The seeds you planted in your 1 year and nurtured in your 2 year are now sprouting. You're in a creative, collaborative, social year, so enjoy the outer expression of those goals now shining through.

4 YEAR: You better work! This is a year for rolling up your sleeves and putting in the work. Basically, if there's hard labor involved to support the seeds you planted in your 1 year, this is the year you'll really be able to do it. Focus, drive, and making stuff happen are all a part of this year.

5 YEAR: Party time! This year brings a focus on play, freedom, joy-seeking, writing, and risk-taking. You'll be experiencing a burst of rebellious, creative energy while you do some celebrating for the seeds you planted in your 1 year.

6 YEAR: Get your house in order! This is a year of repair, domesticity, family, and intimate relationships. You'll be experiencing a healing while you slow down to do some community-building around the seeds you planted in your 1 year.

7 YEAR: Cocoon time! Now, it's all about the inner work, turning deep within, and really stitching together who you want to be in the world going forward. This can be a lonely year if you use this energy to isolate (you *will* need your alone time to get clear and connected with your spiritual gifts). This is a year of building courage. Because the following year will be when you spread your wings around the seeds you planted in your 1 year, the work you do to have the healthiest chrysalis experience possible in a 7 year is important!

8 YEAR: The butterfly emerges! It's time to focus on power as you reveal the inner work you've been doing, step into your potential, and become fully seen. This will be a great year for investing in yourself, basking in the manifestation of all you've created, and taking responsibility for anything that isn't working.

9 YEAR: Closure! The current 9-year cycle will be wrapping up this year. It's time to declutter, prune, and let things go that you'd prefer not to bring with you into your next 9-year cycle. Look for endings, goodbyes, and clarity that's feeling right on time.



Obviously, this is a LOT, and you've probably taken pages of notes during the webinar too. Still, here are some typical questions, answered, in case you find yourself asking 'em.

Q: Okay, so we're using Whole Sign Houses for our charts now?

A: Yep, to keep it simple, we're working with your chart using the Whole Sign House System! Placidus may be the default house system in the site or app you typically use to render your chart, and that's certainly fine for interpreting your chart outside of this free training. In using the much longer-ago established Whole Sign House System, we're assuring the most straightforward way for you to SEE yourself in the stars. The Whole Sign House System democratizes where you were born (no more advantaging the royals who paid the astrologers) while making calculations far more straightforward, because each house starts at the same place a new sign starts. Yay!

Q: I don't know my exact time of birth. Am I screwed?

A: Not at all! Ideally, you'll be able to find out what time you were born from your birth certificate or by checking with a member of your family who remembers some details about the event, like whether the sun had come up yet! Some folks have luck calling the hospital at which they were born to access their archived records. If these options don't work out for you, there is a process called rectification that some astrologers are able to do for a fee. This is a process of studying several significant events in your life while interviewing you to determine the most likely range of birth times. For now, work with what you have! If you're not able to get your birth time sorted out, you can still have a wonderful experience getting to know yourself better. You won't be sure of your RISING, which means the houses may all feel *off* for you, but you'll have the planets in their right signs, and that's plenty to get aligned for an exploration that serves you well. For the sake of rendering your chart without knowing the time, choose a birth time that puts your Moon or your Sun in the 1st house. If you don't know how to do that, just choose sunrise.


Q: There's a tiny R next to one of the planets on my chartwheel. What does this mean?

A: That R indicates retrograde illusion (the varying orbit shapes and speeds of planets we're *not* living on making it appear as if they're moving backward from time to time as we ALL orbit the Sun). Any planet on your chartwheel with a tiny R next to it was retrograde at the time of your birth. The fun part about this is that when that same planet goes retrograde throughout your life, you're actually less distressed by its effects than other folks may be. Overall, the WHAT of that planet will likely have your focus turned more inward in life. Also, your development in the area of that planet's WHAT may be later in life.

Q: Nearly half of my houses are totally empty on the chartwheel. What does this mean?

A: It actually means you're like most people.;) The typical experience is to have a few planets or placements clustering in one quadrant of your chart or even together in a single sign or house "stellium" (clumping our lessons and gifts so they can serve one another and experience transits with similar timing) and then open spaces. Of course, even "empty" houses are in specific signs in your natal chart, so there's definitely energy there! In fact, depending on what's directly opposite that house on the chartwheel, that "empty" energy could be exactly what you're meant to use to balance out all that activity on the other side of your chart. Cool, huh?

final thoughts:

I often hear that astrology is overwhelming. So many signs and planets and houses (Oh, my!) and that's before we even get into aspects and transits and retrogrades and fixed stars and annual profections and secondary progressions and zodiacal releasing and firdaria and, and, and.

This is why I adore bringing my childhood love of astrological storytelling into the here and now. We can make meaning of so many of the parts of our charts! But the whole point of this exploration is for us to be empowered, to have sovereignty, to lean into what we may already be feeling is right... confident that it's exactly what our souls intended that we do!

While I believe in magic, I also love data. I love tracking patterns. And I especially love when I notice that data backs up something magical. The placebo effect is scientifically backed. Even when we know we're taking a placebo for a headache, the brain will send signals that relieve us from perceived pain. So while some folks may roll their eyes at my adherence to planetary hours or about some of the rituals I swear by in order to achieve **Chart Harmony**, I know what works for me. Hopefully you're now feeling more confident around your woo-curious setpoint, too.

And when you get turned around? Just come back to these tools. Connect with the work you've put into this with me, align with the energies that are here to support you, and breathe. Trust your KNOWING. You've got this!
